This year, there is an increase of more than 150% in the activities when compared to 2020-21. Total number of students participated is increased more than 200%.

Indian Science Technology and Engineering facilities Map (I-STEM)

ISTEM is an initiative by Government of India, where the existing research facilities can be used by various other institutes, scholars and private organizations.

Our College is registered under ISTEM recently and the research infrastructure available in the institute is made visible for all users and scholars across PAN India.

Science departments (Physics, Chemistry and Zoology) had collated the instruments which we are in working condition in our campus. The instruments were purchased over the last decade and the details were uploaded in ISTEM.

Around 50 instruments were updated in the portal so for. The price list for the usage / depreciation of the instruments also been worked out and updated against all the instruments.

SARWODEEP is a social service unit of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women (Autonomous), Periyakulam. It has now expanded widely with its progressive activities regarding women empowerment, child development, youth Development, capacity building, livelihood promotion, skill training, Health education, the welfare of widows and that of the differently abled special children

Through SARWODEEP, 2734 children with disabilities were diagnosed from Theni District, 2083 were enrolled in SSA centre and were provided with the opportunity for education. It has assisted 405 disabled persons to get ID cards, 156 persons with disability to receive care allowance. Under Vazhikattum Thittam, 1961 Persons with Disability have benefitted. Help is offered to the disabled to get free equipment from the government like Wheel Chair, Walking Stick, Scooter, Tricycle, Callipers and Sewing Machine. SARWODEEP has

provided employment opportunities for the disabled through STAR SHG, Akil SHG, Acca Press, Healthy Napkin Unit, Star Garments, Paper Recycling Unit etc. Venci SHG members were procured direct loans worth ₹ 4,80,000/- from IOB. 18 students have completed Online Diploma Courses through under TNOU through JAC Community College. Sarwodeephas helped for more than 100 Self Help Groups. By the initiation of SARWODEEP, Khadi and Village Industries Commission, Madurai (KVIC), NABARD gave free earthenware making machines to 40 potters. SARWODEEP has taken further efforts to give importance to Conservation of Environment by establishing Paper Recycling Unit, a pioneering initiative in Theni Dt.
