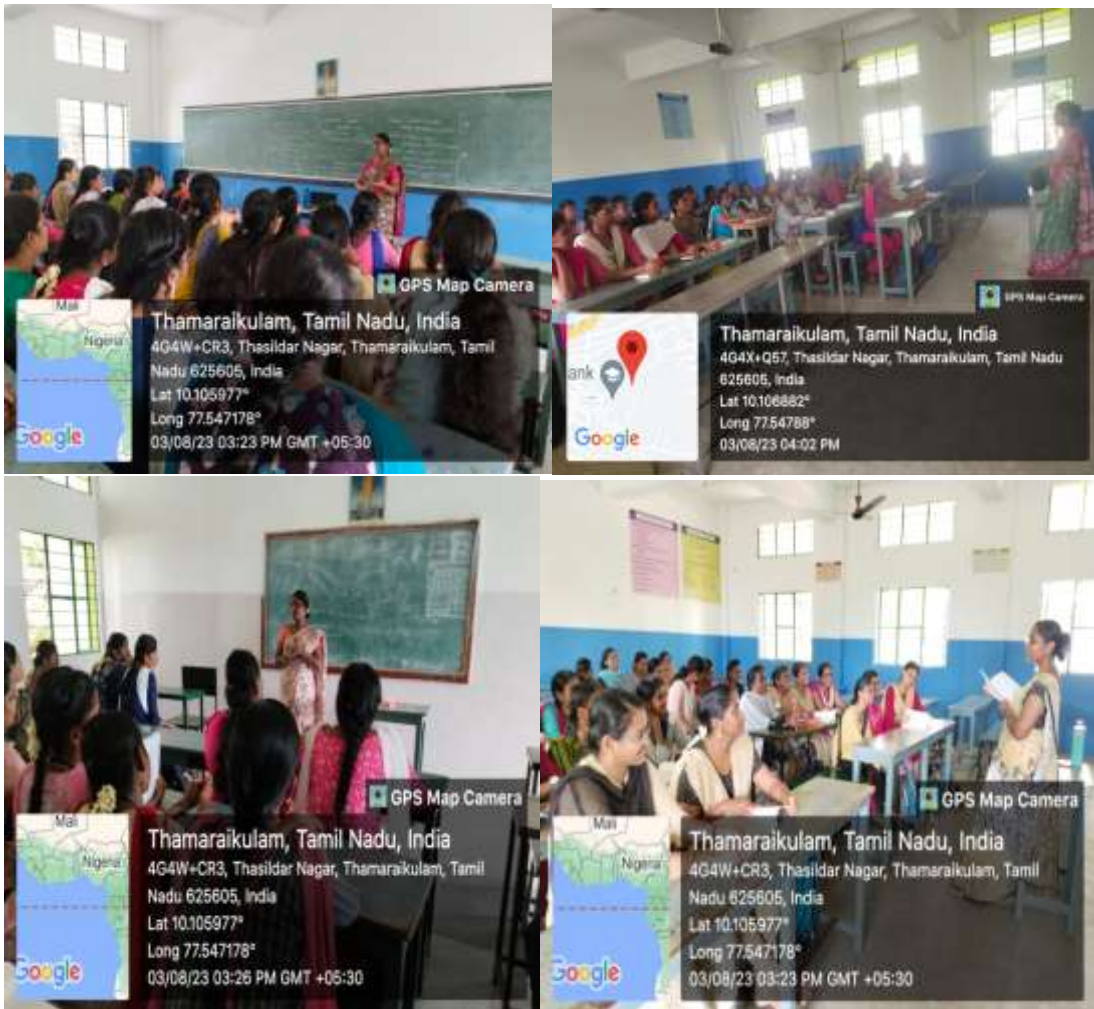
8. Brief description of the event :
