He explained the students the method of identification of different types of butterflies by observing the color, patterns and their host plant. The students enthusiastically participated in the event and documented more than 40 species of butterfly and identified more than 70 types of birds in JAC campus. 114 students were benefitted from this Programme.



Synchronized Bird Census -2024 (Phase I – Wetland Birds) conducted by Srivilliputhur Megamalai Tiger Reseeve,Megamalai Division Theni organized by Tamil Nadu Forest Department on 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> January2024.Ten students and Two faculty members represented the college as volunteers in the Bird Census Programme.The students were divided into small teams and visited the different wetland areas of Kandamanur in Theni district from 6.00 am to 9.00 am. The participants were accompanied by two forest ranger officers and a birding expert. The students were given a detailed orientation on bird identification protocols and use of field guides during the survey, The students were actively involved in observing different types of bird species noting their behavior and frequency, through this session the students gained an in-depth knowledge on avian diversity in the local environment and their correlation with ecosystem.
