#### AGRICULTURAL WELFARE SCHEMES – 21.11.2023

On 21.11.2023, the National Service Scheme, Unit- 7 of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women, took a step towards promoting agricultural well-being in Periyakulam's Endapuli Panchayat, Nehru Nagar on 21.11.2023 at 3.00 p.m. Mr. N. Ramasamy, the Assistant Director of Agriculture in Theni, was crucial in enlightening the community about various agricultural welfare schemes. The event began with a recognition of agriculture's significance as our country's backbone. Emphasizing the government's efforts to enhance yields and boost production, Mr. Ramasamy delved into the details of agricultural welfare schemes. The audience was then explained about the Ullavan app, with its applications in agriculture, horticulture, sales, and business sectors. Financial assistance and credit avenues through the Kisan Credit Card (KCC) and the Prime Minister's Crop Insurance Scheme were elucidated, fostering awareness among the attendees. Mr. Ramasamy also shed light on obtaining government subsidies for 16 types of fertilizers, outlining the micro-nutrient scheme's role in providing essential nutrients to crops. The focus shifted to environmentally friendly practices, with the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare promoting non-toxic bio compost and liquid biofertilizers. These initiatives aimed to maintain soil health and increase agricultural vields.

Mrs. G. Renuka, Assistant Director of Agriculture in Periyakulam, emphasized the importance of soil testing, offering students the opportunity to explore soil fertility for a nominal fee of Rs.20. The event saw the active participation of Mr. Nivesh, Agriculture Officer, and Mr. Manikandan, Assistant Technical Manager, who presented insights into the Agricultural Welfare Scheme. Notably, 20 farming families from Nehru Nagar directly benefited from the knowledge shared. Mrs. Abinaya, NSS Programme Officer, and Mrs. Amala Jasmine meticulously coordinated the event.

#### **CULTURAL PROGRAMME – 22.11.2023**



Six women were selected to serve in Catering-Sarwodeep Health Centers, and six dropouts underwent thorough counseling, leading them to agree to join a one-year nursing course at Sarwodeep Nursing Training. The program was organized by Mrs. Abinaya, the NSS Program Officer, and Dr. Amala Jasmine, NSS staff Advisor. As a result of this event, the livelihoods of 50 women in Nehru Nagar were significantly enhanced.
