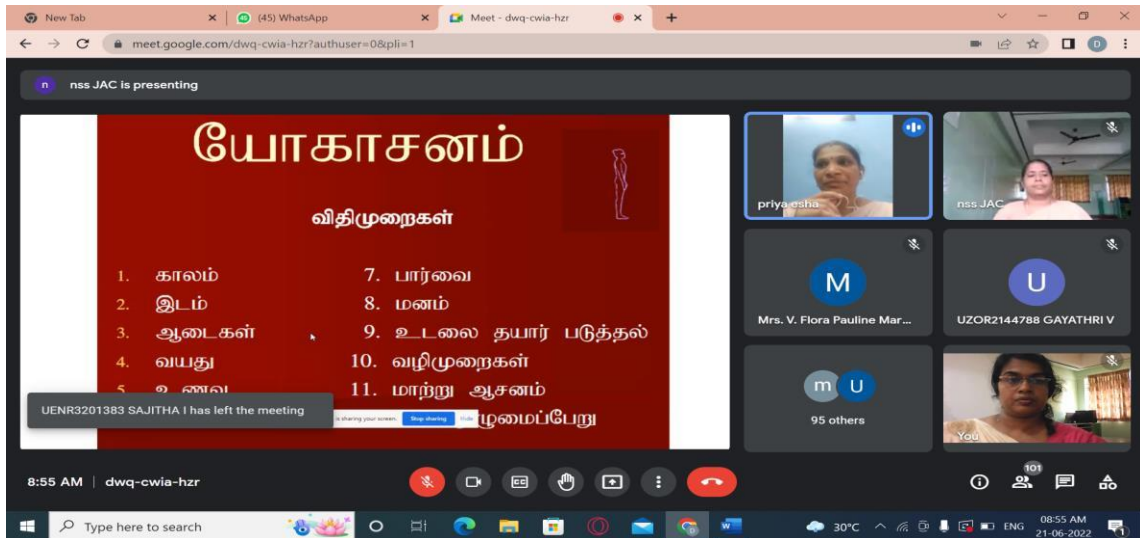

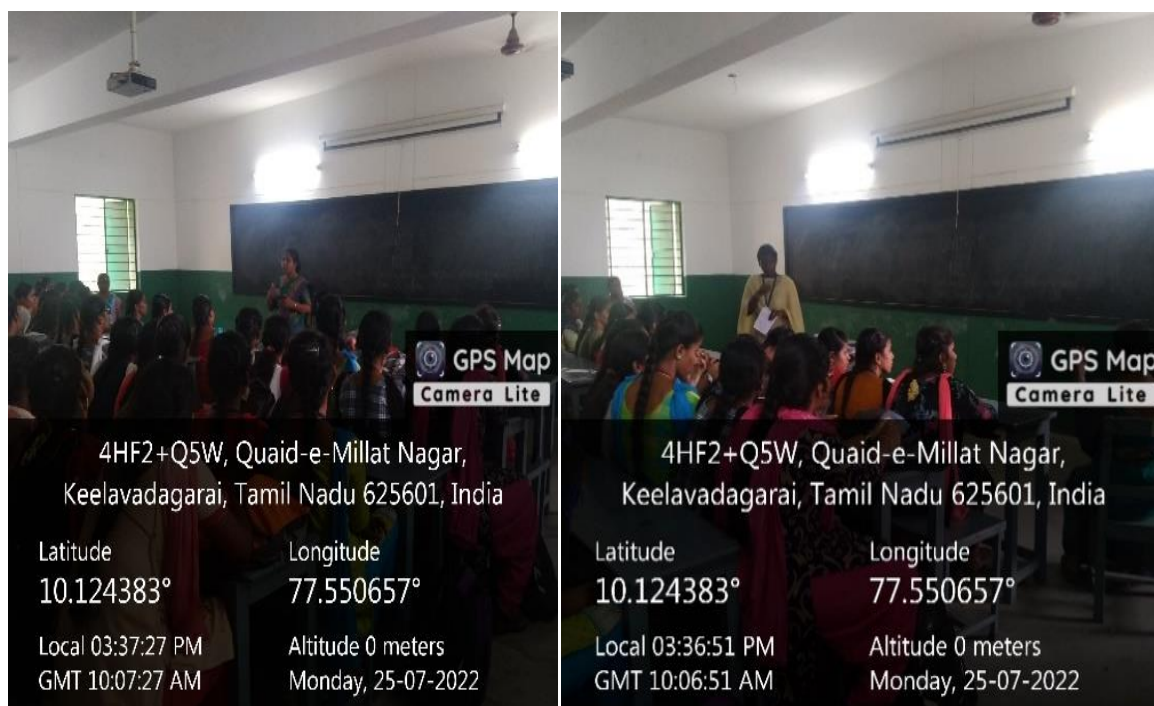


MONTH OF JULY

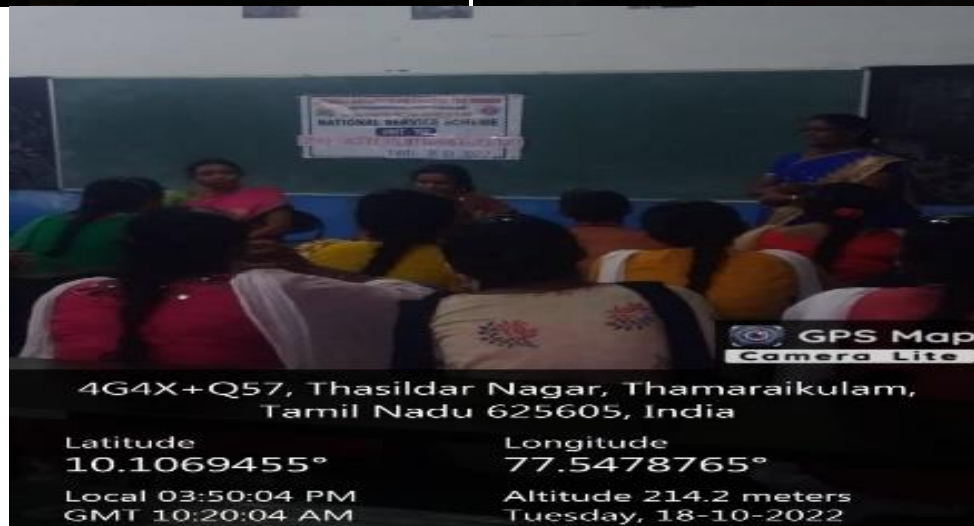
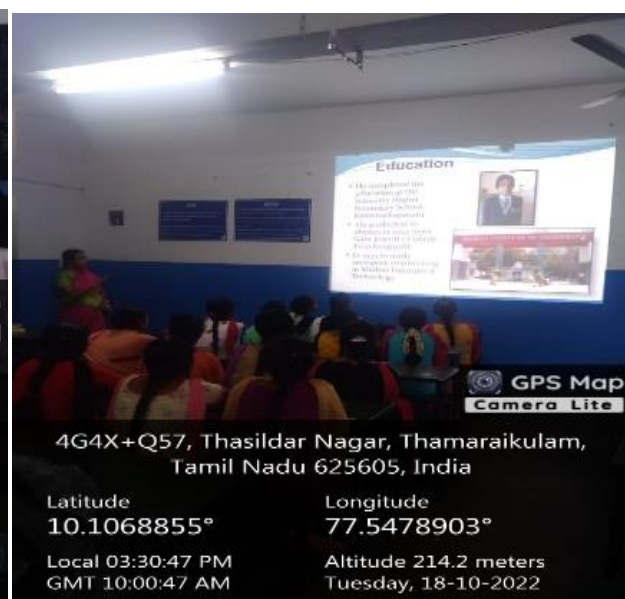
Blood Donation Awareness Programme 07.10.2022
