

Report for the Month of August 2022

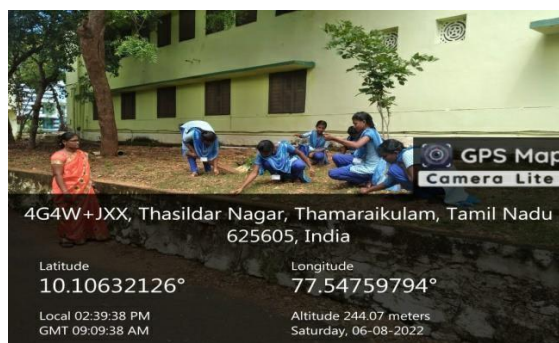
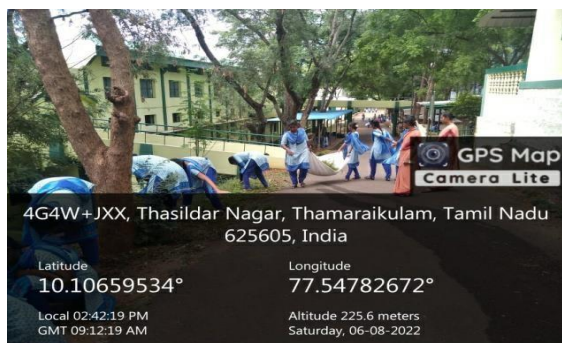
04.08.2022 - NSS Orientation Programme

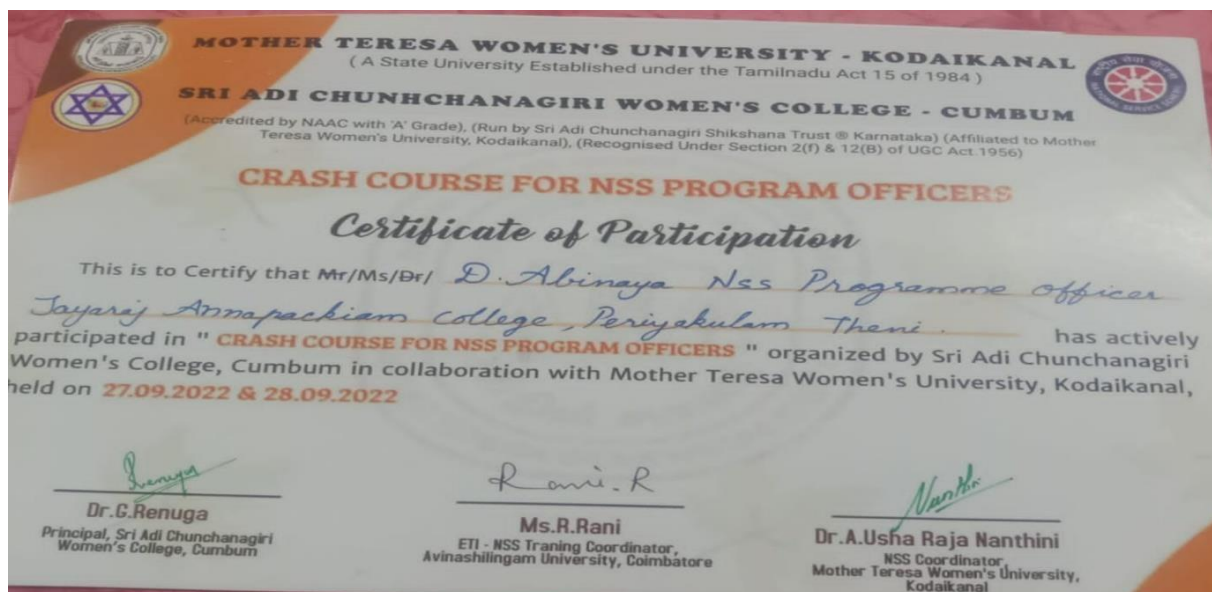
21. 09. 2022 – Cleaning Campus

27.09.2022 & 28.09.2022 – CRASH COURSE

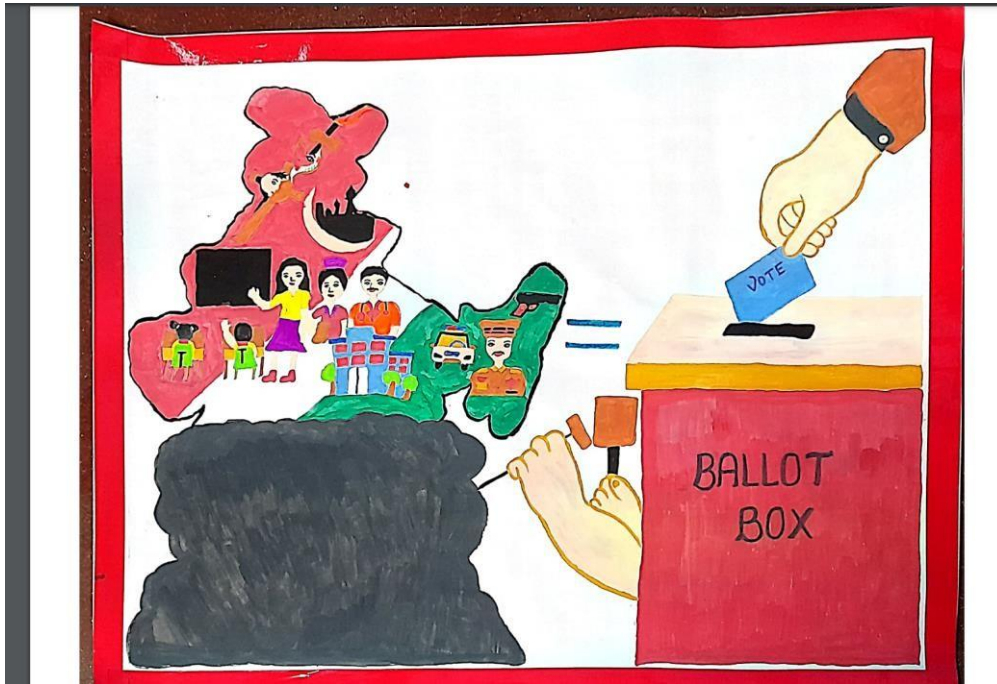

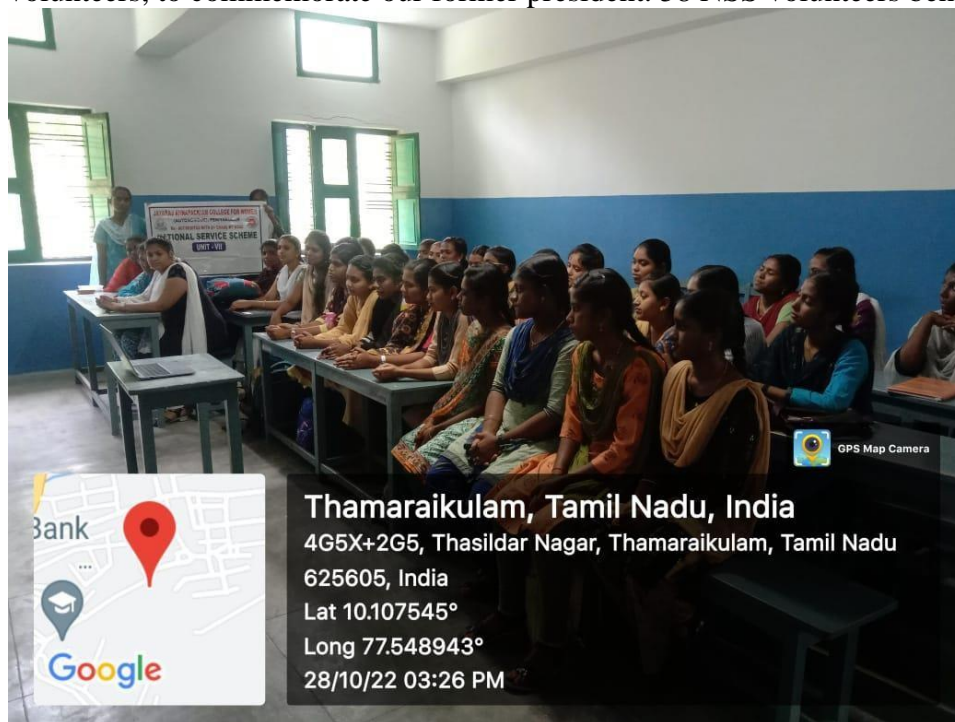
28.10.2022 - Cleanliness Drive

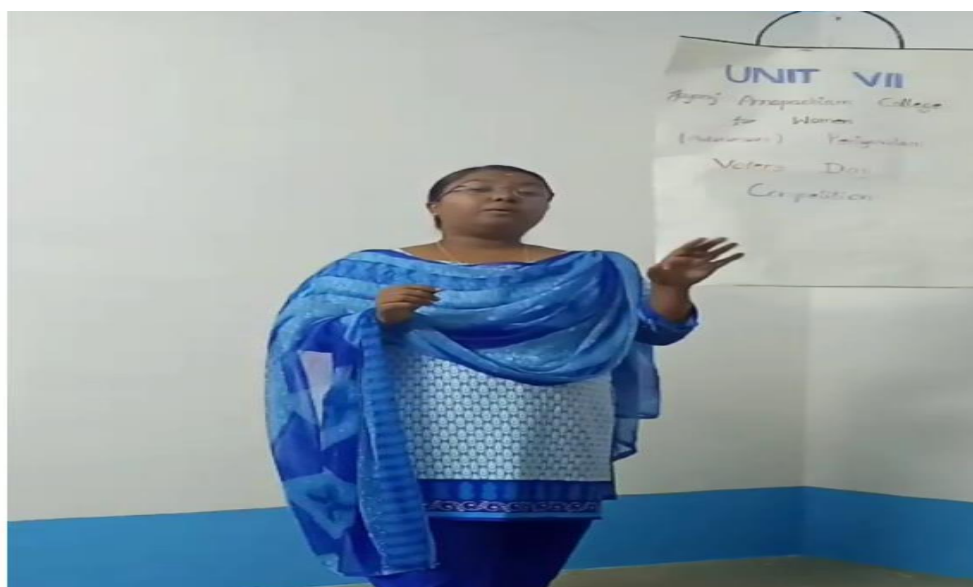

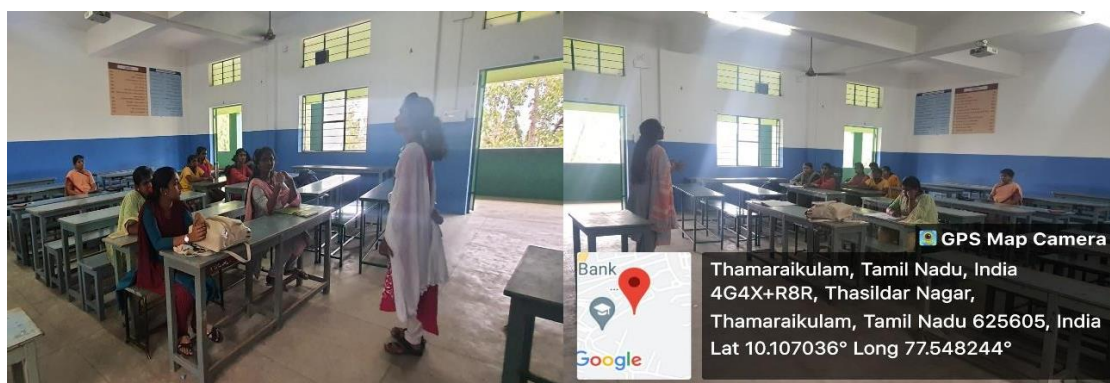
13.01.2023 - Pongal Celebration

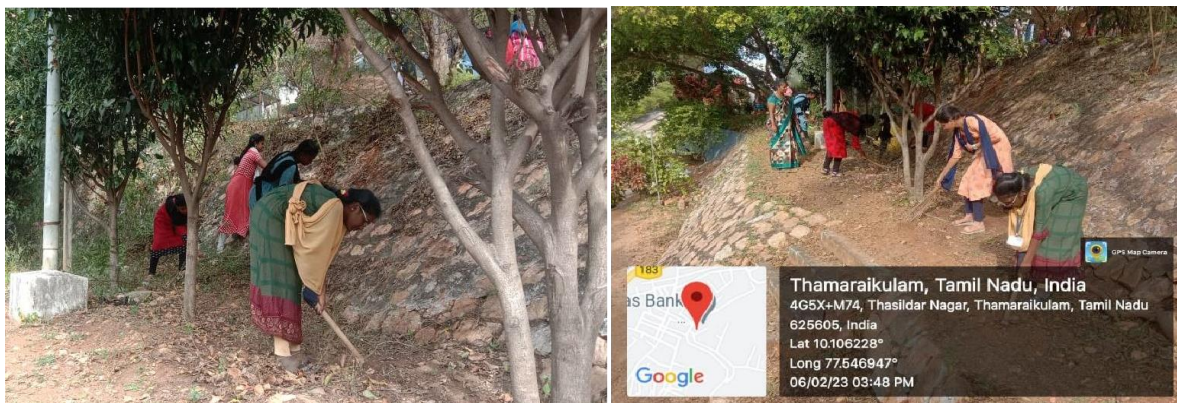

Report for the month of February 2023

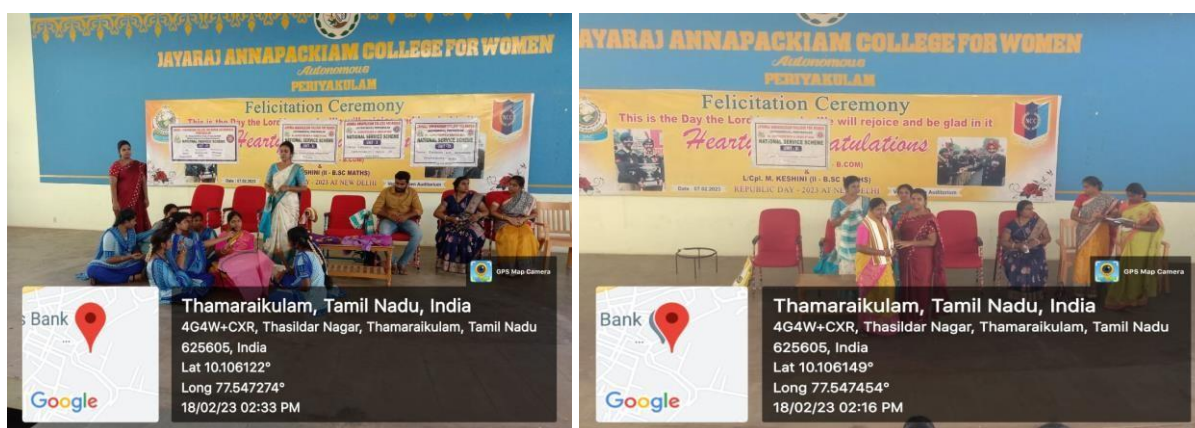
06.02.2023 - Cleanliness activities

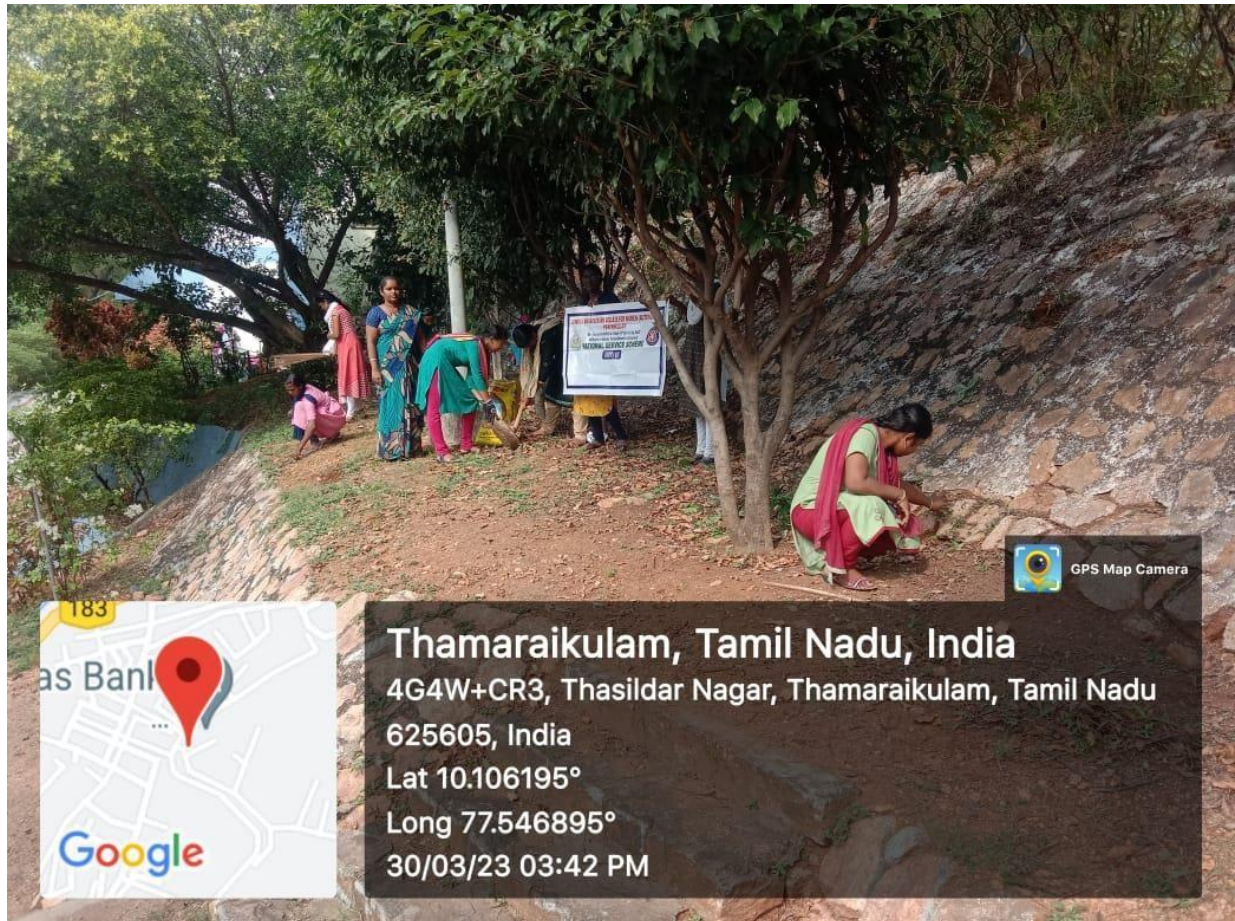
1. Pasting various bills on charts, along with the explanation for all taxes.

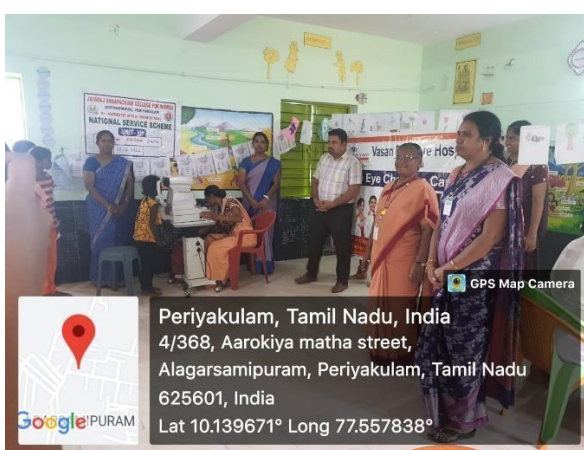
Outcome: Yoga was made compulsory by Government school principal during all their gatherings.





FREE EYE CAMP

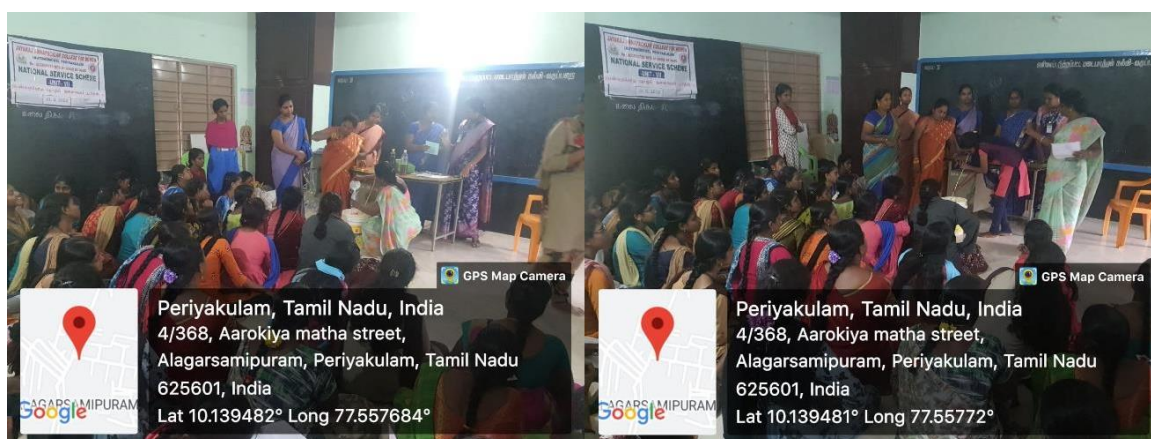

ENTREPRENEUR TRAINING FOR WOMEN PHASE- I

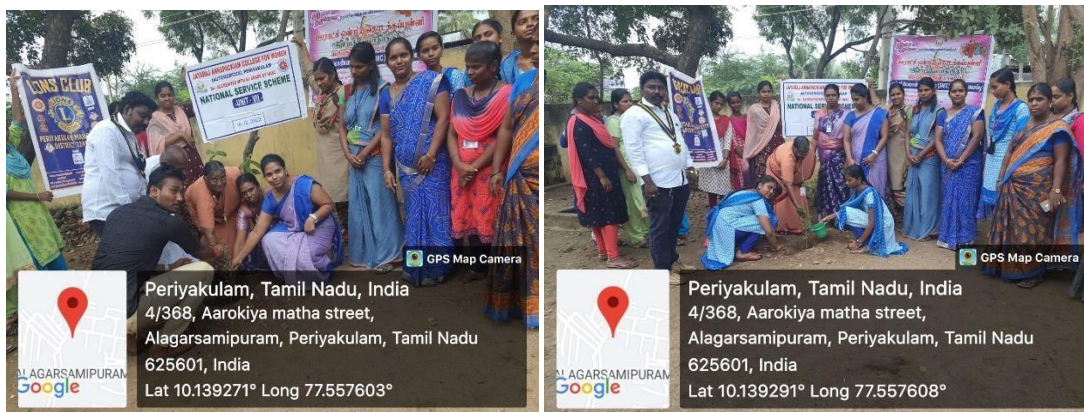

Outcome: An employment opportunity was created for five women.

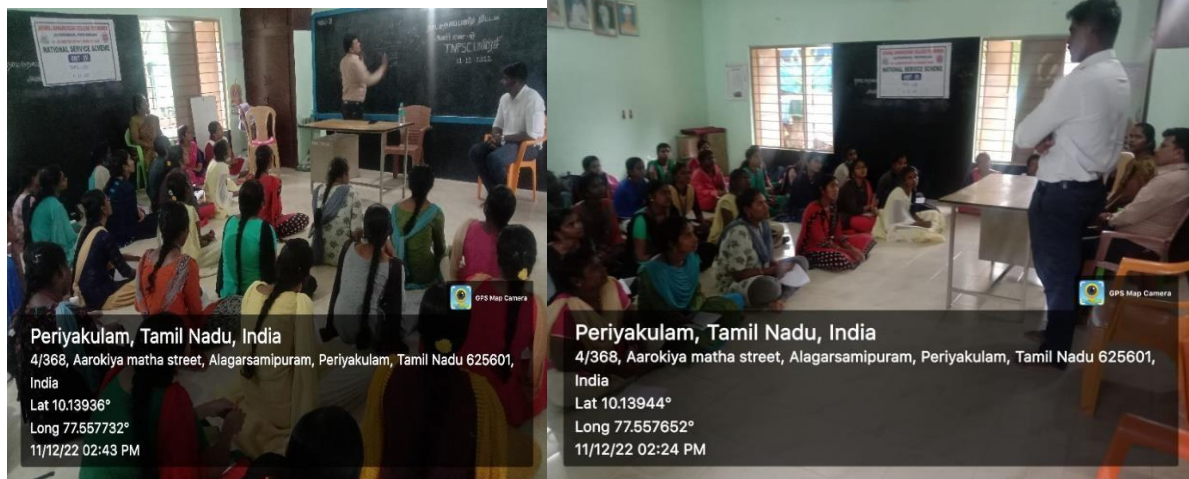


TNPSC COACHING

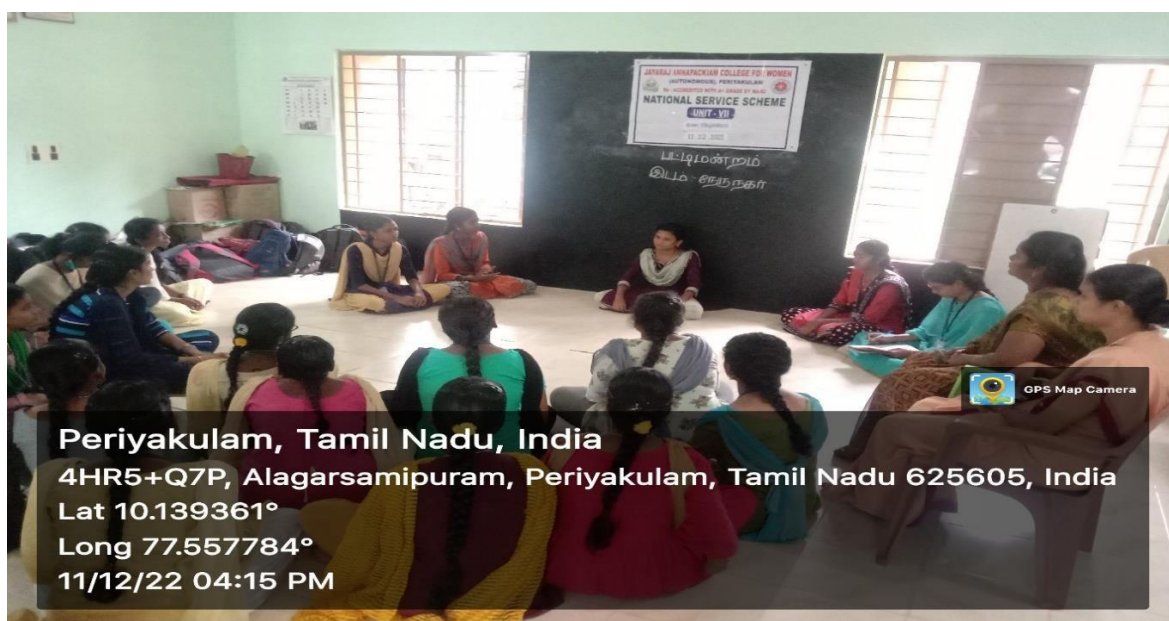

VALNDU KATTUVOM

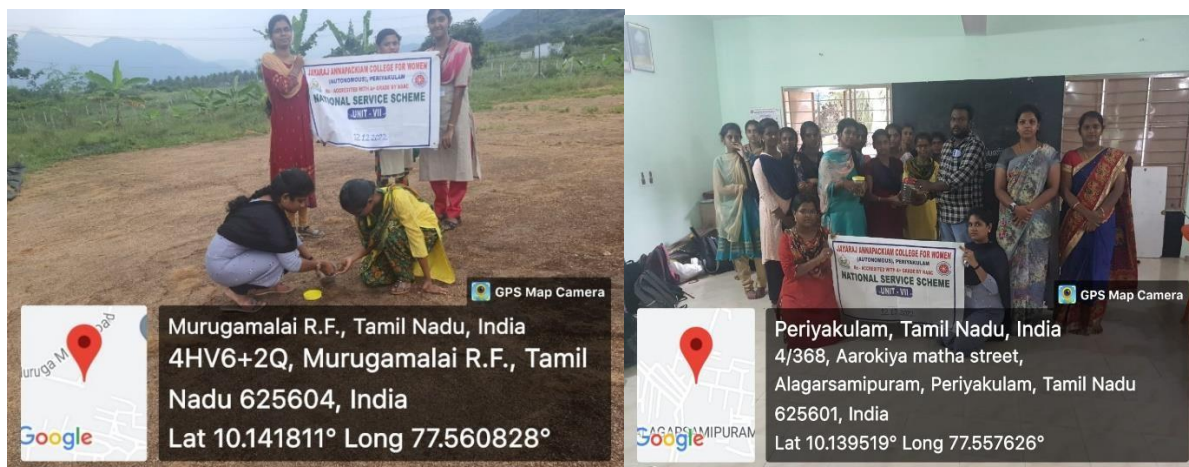
