






Swachh India -29.10.2022



01.11.2022 - Panchayat union primary school, Irumalainayakkanpatti – building renovation








Report for the month of January - 2023

Women, Periyakulam. It really gave them an exposure to pursue their higher education. It is a good step to make the first generation to enter into college without fear.




Providing Iron tablets to Students - 01.02.2023
