

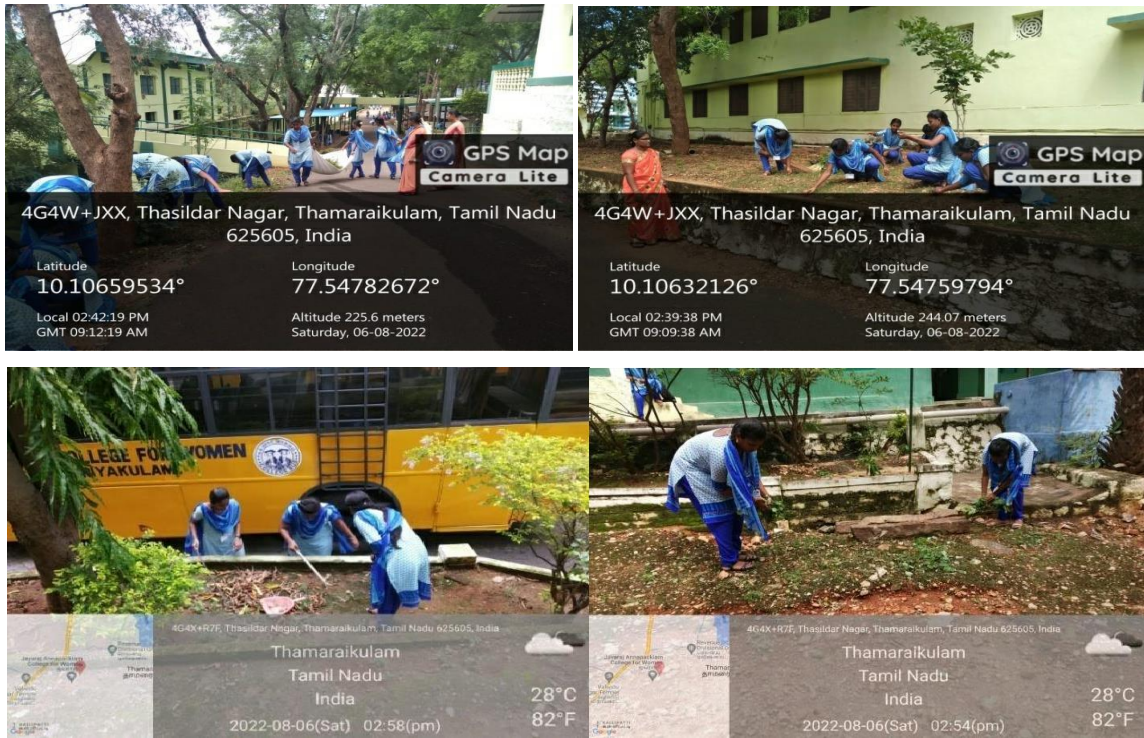
Month of August 2022
