Day 1 - 08.12.2022 (Thursday)

Inauguration - 08.12.2022

Under the National Service Scheme of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women (Autonomous), Periyakulam organised a Special Camp in the Endapuli Panchayat from December 8-14, 2022.
