Day 1 - 8.12.2022

#### **Inauguration Ceremony**

The National Service Scheme of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women (Autonomous), Periyakulam organized a Special camp in Endapuli Panchayat covering villages namely J. K Colony, Kakanji, Nehru Nagar, Annamalai Nagar, Arockia Madha Nagar, E. Pudhukottai, Murugamali from 08.12.2022 to 14.12.2022. The theme of the special camp was 'We create a new World'. It was begun at 10.00 am with a prayer song. Dr. Padmashree, PO of Unit 10 welcomed the gathering. This was inaugurated by Mr. M. Pandiyan, Panchayat Officer. He motivated the students to be the responsible and appreciated the programmes which are going to be done in the next seven days. He felt the need of creating awareness among the village people. Our Principal Rev. Sr. Dr. S. Jesurani delivered felicitation speech and motivated the students to do the activities with their mind and heart. Rev. Sr. B. J. Queensly Jeyanthi delivered a blessed message to be fit and healthy enough to fulfill the activities in the upcoming days. Through our college and the efforts of Unit 11 we donated an Almirah for the School to keep the books which we collected from our students by all Units and those books were handed over to Mrs. A. #### Sapling Plantation Preparatory Work -Digging Holes

We conversed in English with the children.
