**Inauguration Ceremony**

The National Service Scheme of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women (Autonomous), Periyakulam organized a Special camp in Endapuli Panchayat covering villages namely J.K Colony, Kakanji Nagar, Nehru Nagar, Annamalai Nagar, Arockia Madha Nagar, E.Pudhukottai, Murugamali from 08.12.2022 to 14.12.2022. The theme of the special camp is 'We create a new World'. Camp started at 10.00 am with a prayer song. Dr. Padmashree, Program Officer welcomed the gathering. The program was inaugurated by Mr.M. Pandiyan, Endapuli Panchayat President. Principal Rev.Sr.Dr.S. Jesurani of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women delivered felicitation address and motivated the students. Dirt collected is dumped into boxes and is swept into piles along the gutters and loaded directly into trucks.

### **Personality Development – 13.12.2022**

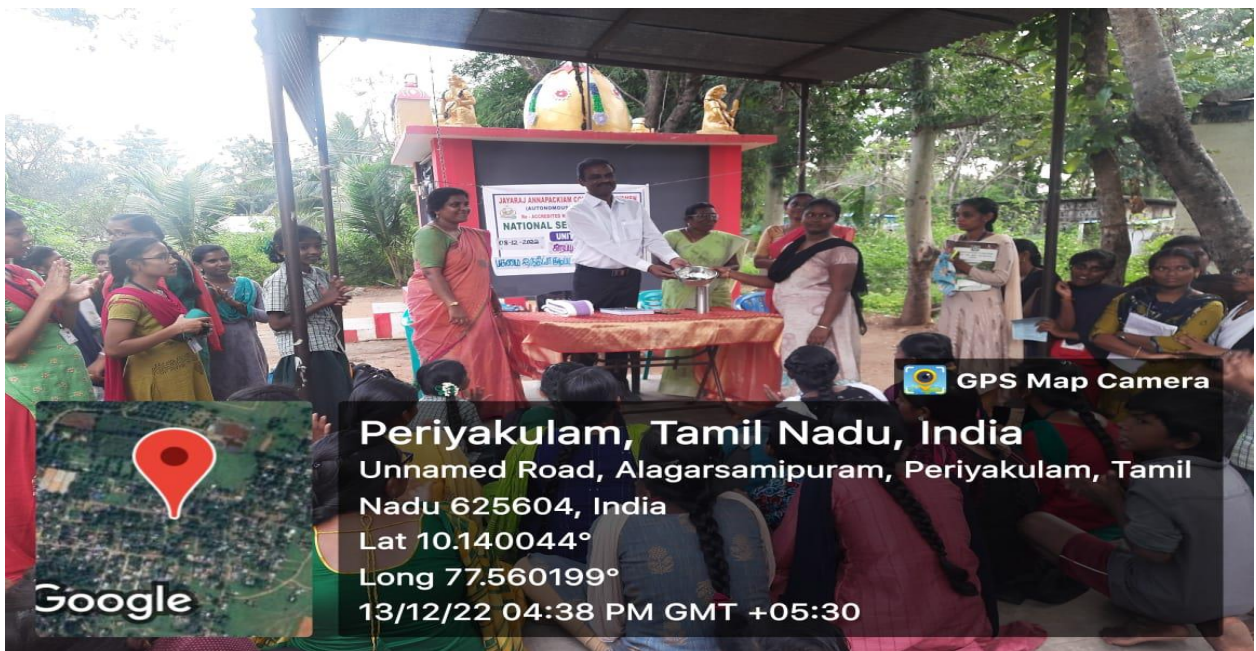
