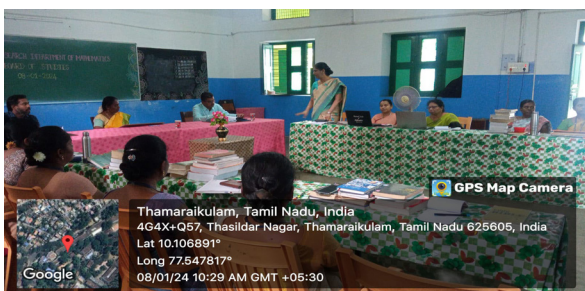
- All the Departments organized Alumnae Meeting for the 2022-2023 passed out UG and PG students on 1st and 2nd December, 2023.
