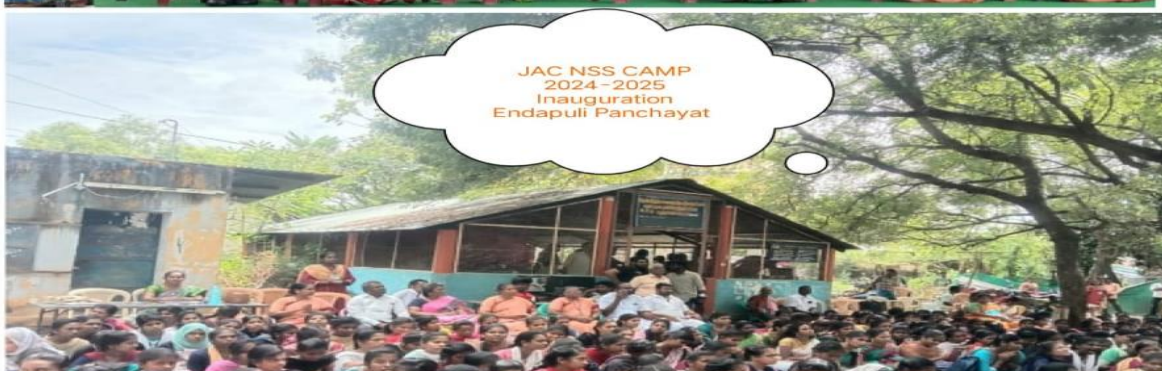
SPECIAL CAMP REPORT 2024 -2025

DAY 1 – 14.11.2024

INAGURATION

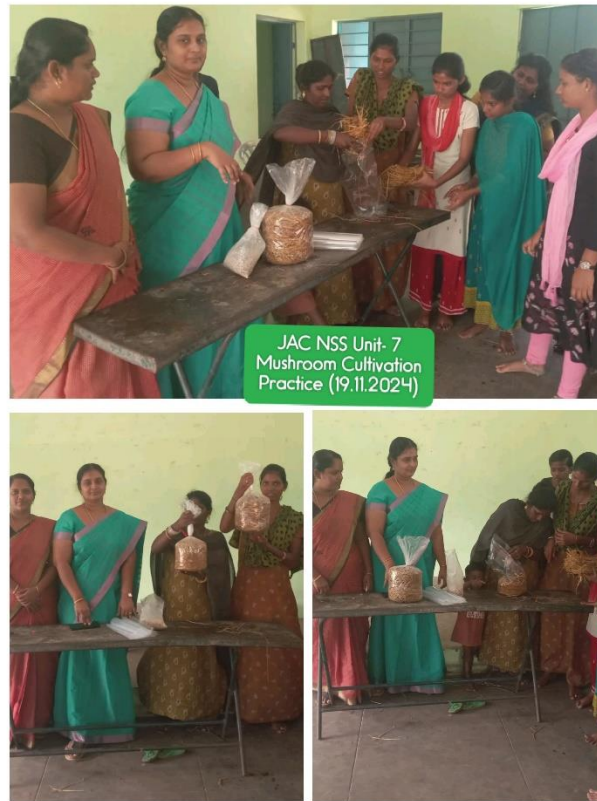
TNPSC COACHING
