## CAMPUS HIGHLIGHTS

- ✎ An Exam Committee Meeting was held on 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 by the Controller of Examinations, Dr. Sr. A. Irudaya Lourdu Gladis. Key discussions included the April semester exam timetable and ensuring the smooth conduct of examinations. The meeting was attended by Principal Dr. Sr. S. Jesuarani, Dr. C. Mary Anbarasi (Exam Chief Superintendent), Sr. Sahayam (Office Chief Superintendent), and Heads of Departments.
