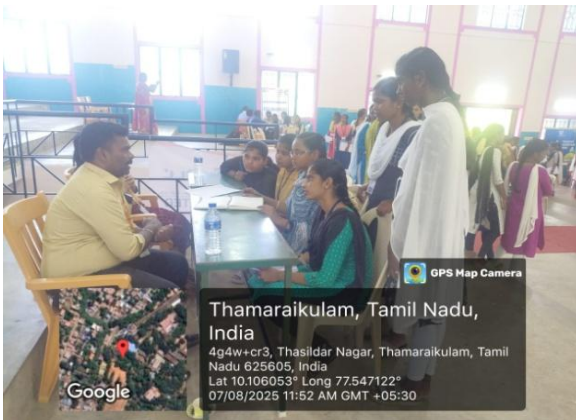

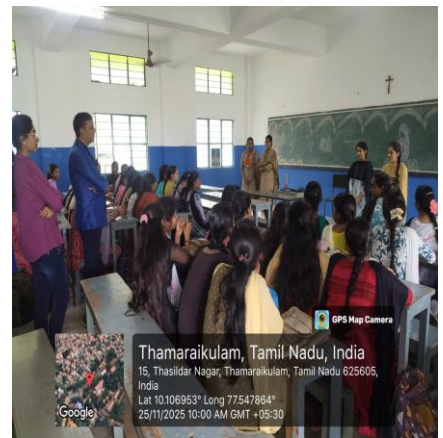
**6. Brief description of the event:**

Nearly 500 students participated in the event, attending sessions that were aimed at improving their communication, resume writing, group discussion, and interview skills.
