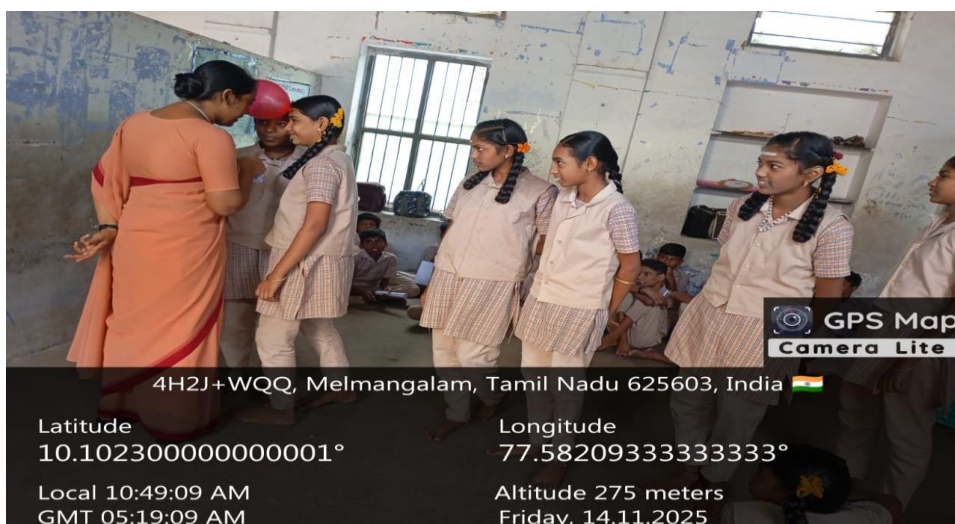


Day 3: 14.11.2025

SPECIAL EYE CAMP-15.11.2025

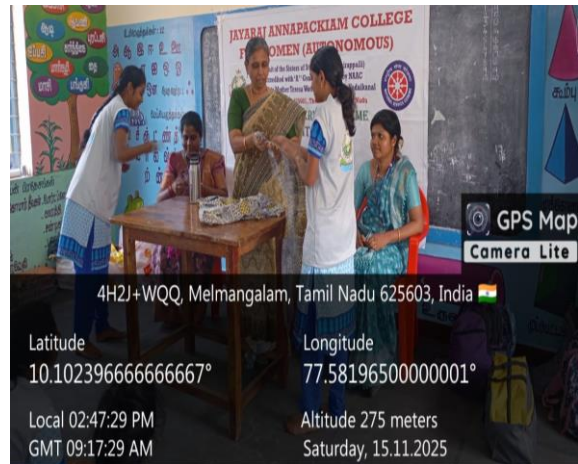
