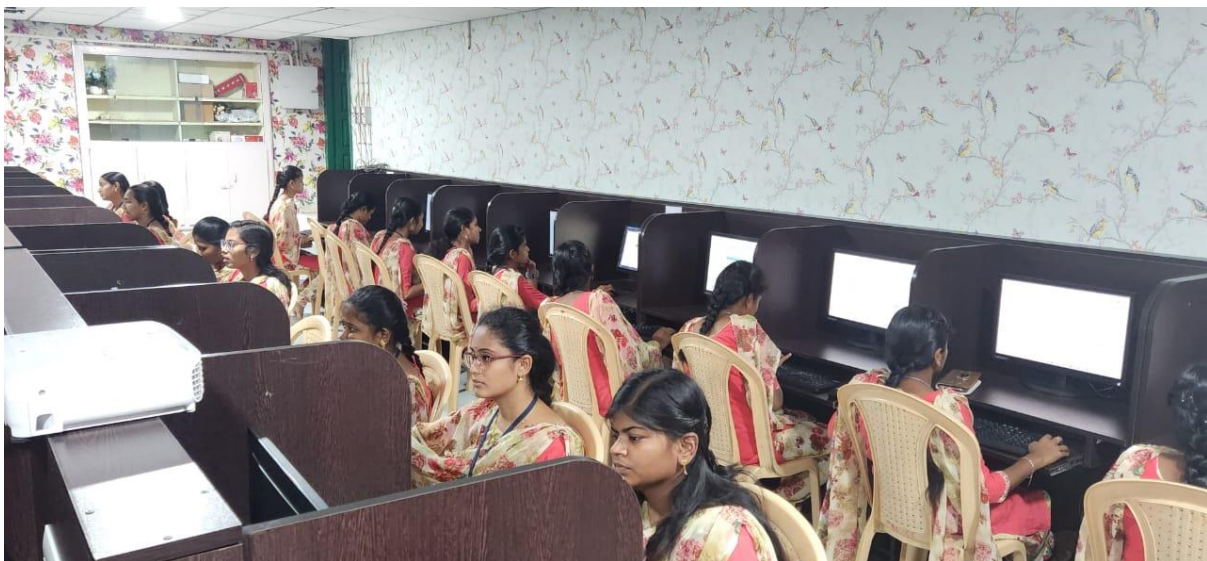
The **Tech Quiz** consisted of multiple rounds, covering topics such as:

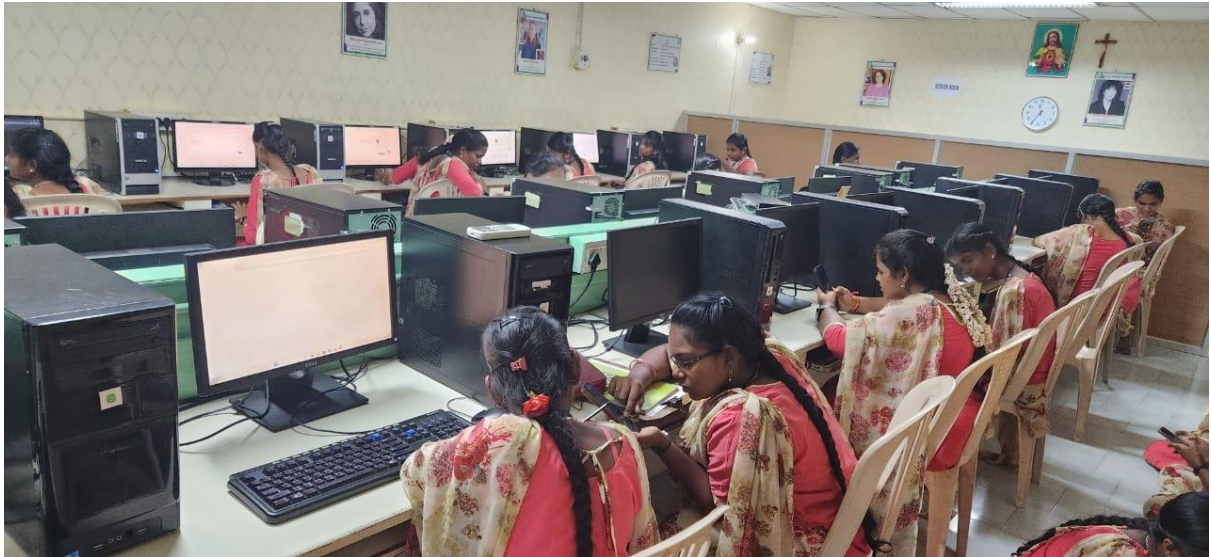
- Fundamentals of Computer Science

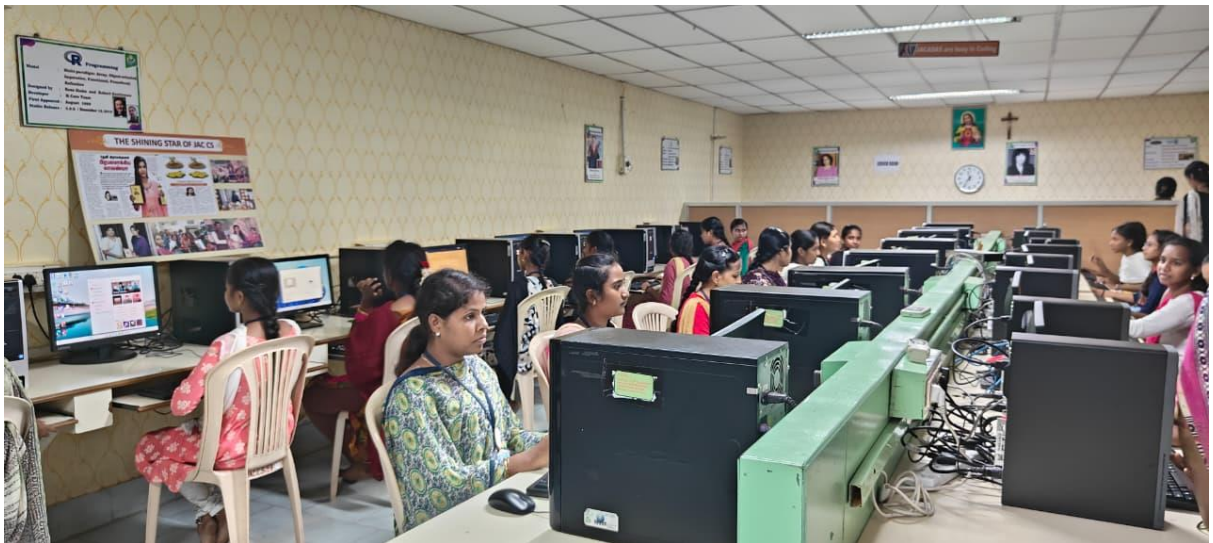
their digital competence and to explore technology with confidence and curiosity.

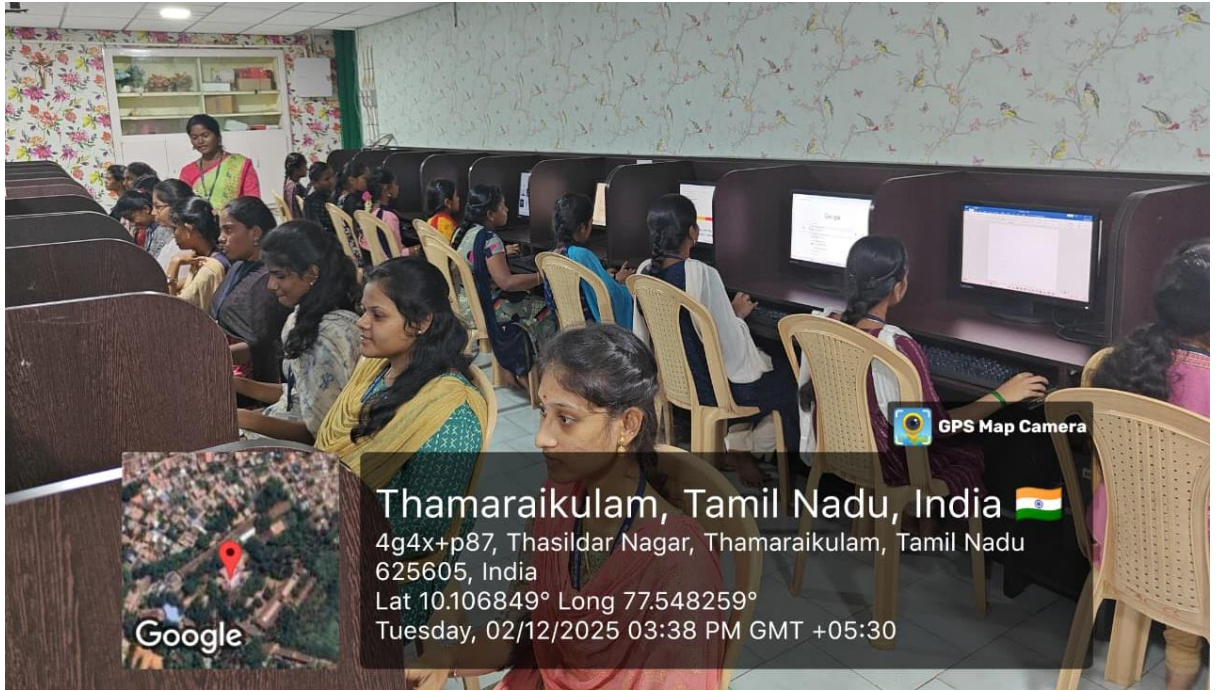
