Scope and Functions:

1. Creating awareness on local, migratory, endemic, and threatened bird species with special reference to regional wetlands and forest ecosystem.
2. Train the students in bird watching, identification, and documentation using standard scientific methods such as point count and transect surveys.
3. To organise nature walks, bird census programmes, and field visits to wetlands, and biodiversity-rich areas.
4. Promoting student-led research projects related to avian diversity, feeding behaviour, seasonal migration, and habitat use.
5. Conducting lectures, photography contests, and bird watching on bird conservation themes.
6. Observing important environmental days such as World Sparrow Day, World Wetlands Day etc.
7. To collaborate with the forest department, local bird watchers, NGOs and research institutes for outreach activities.
8. To participate in local and global bird count programmes organized by the government and non-governmental sectors.
