GUEST LECTURE

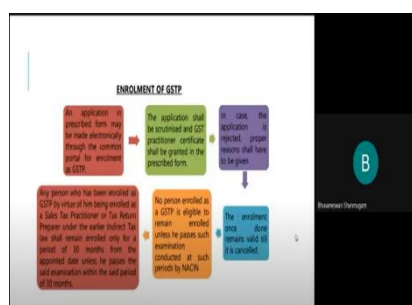
18.08.2021

03.09.2021

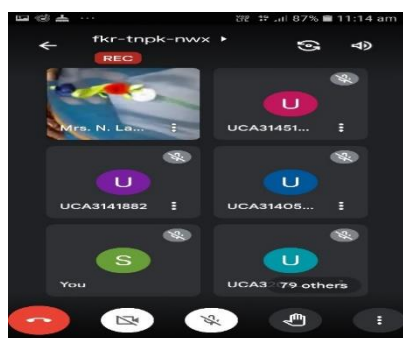

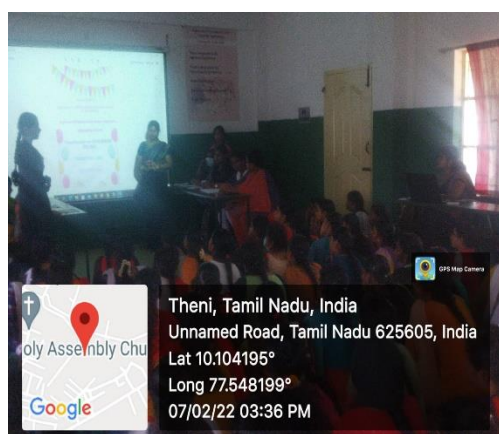

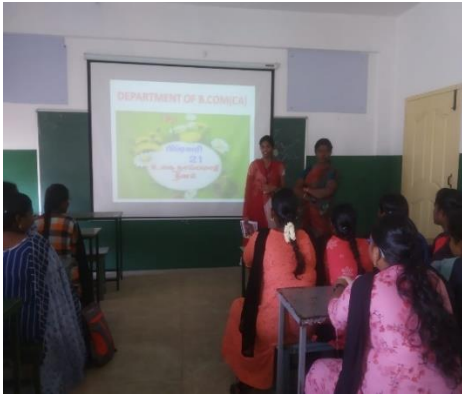
International Mother Tongue Day
