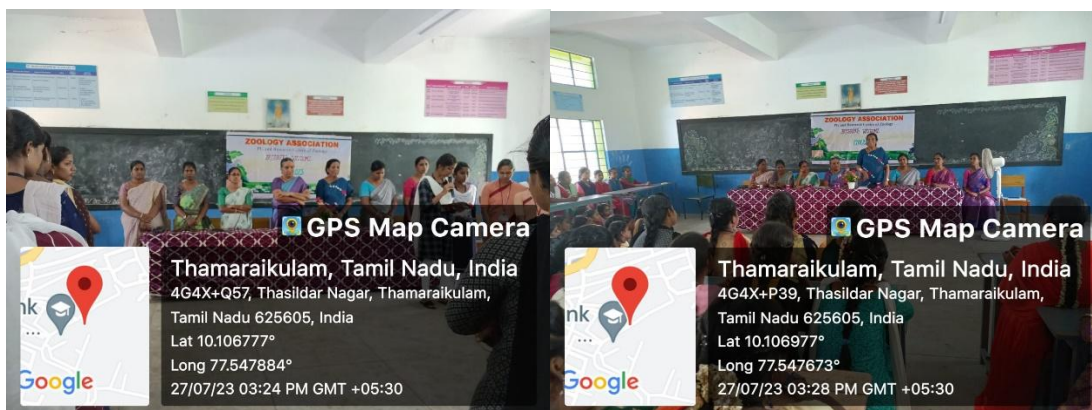
PG AND RESEARCH CENTRE OF ZOOLOGY

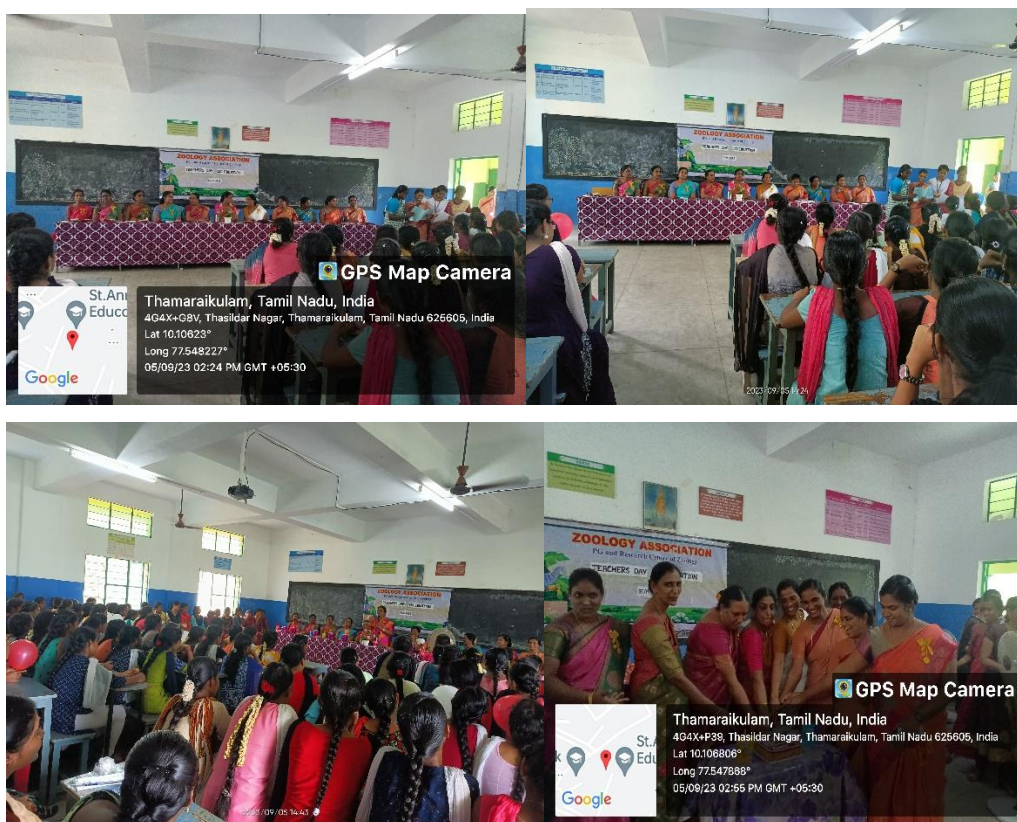

5. The students of PG and Research Centre of Zoology celebrated “Teachers Day” on 5th September 2023 at 2.00 PM.



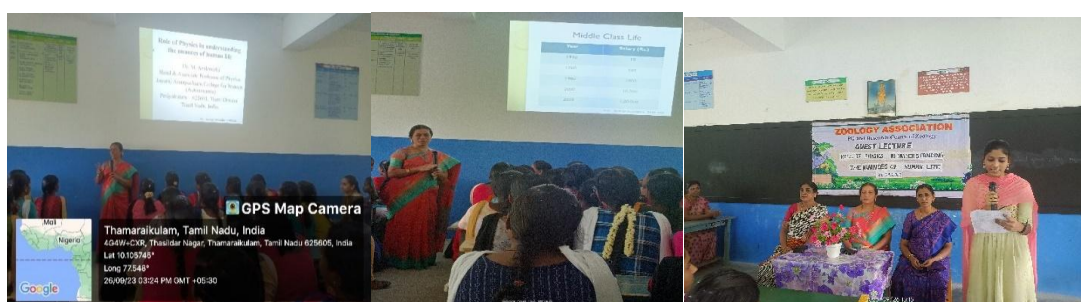

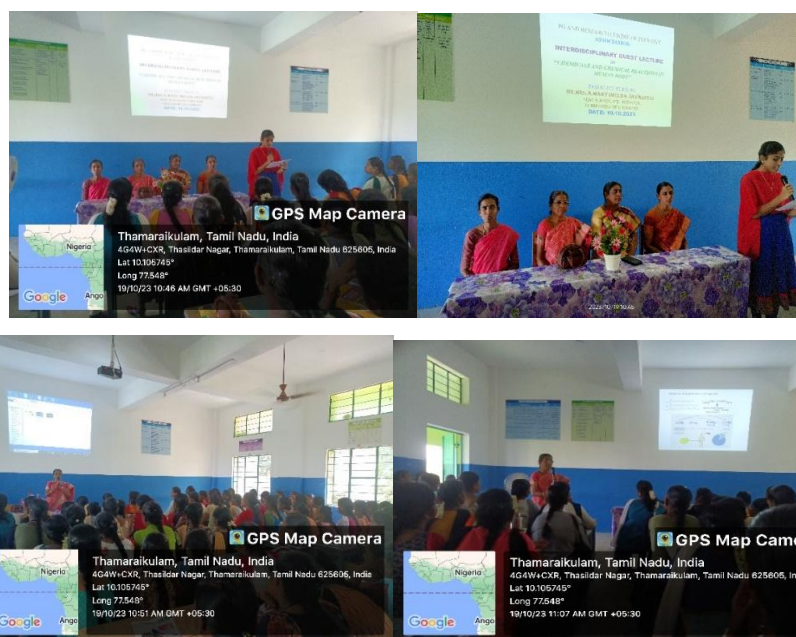

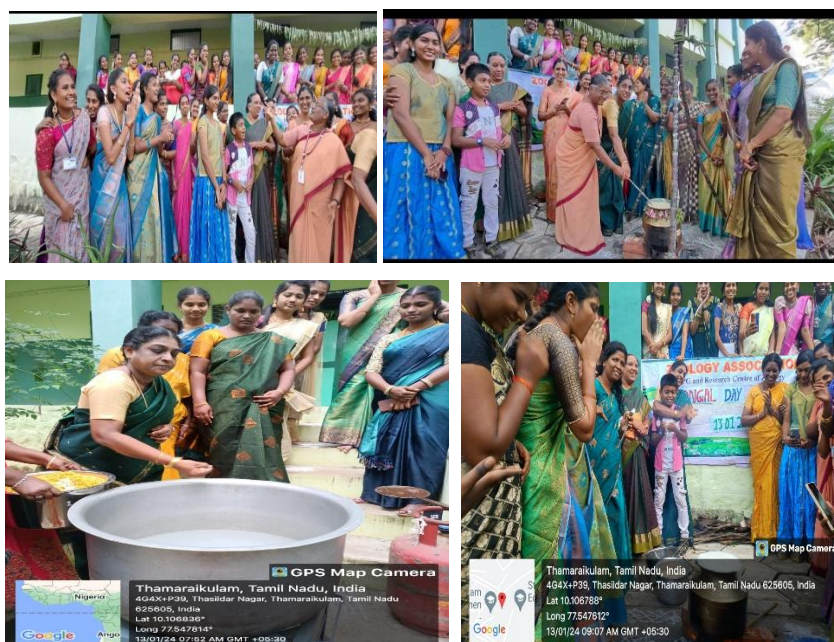
