### **INTERNATIONAL GUEST LECTURE**

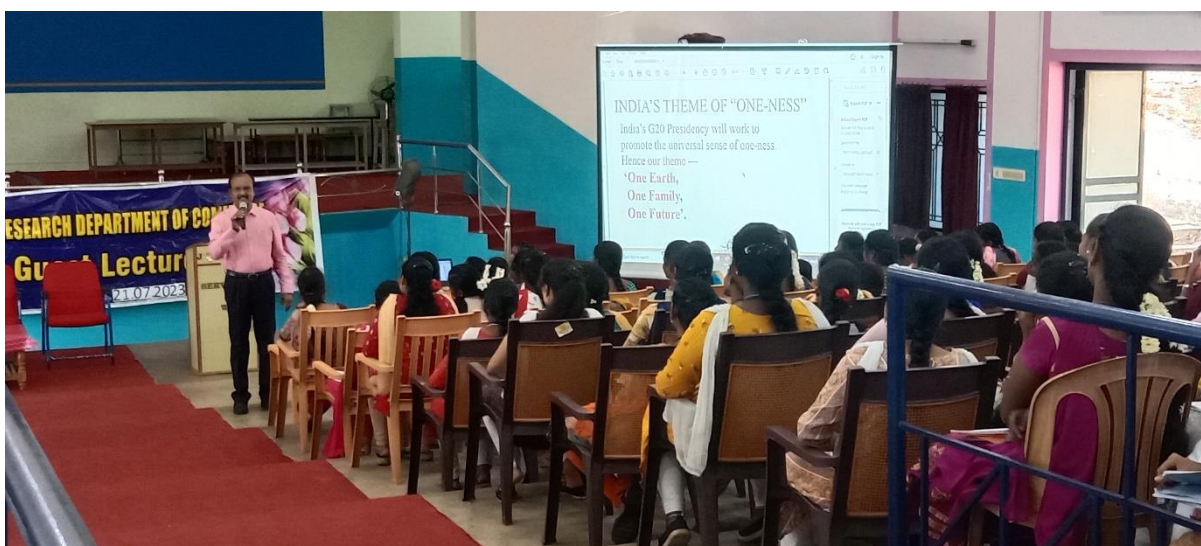

Dr. P. Ravichandran, Head and Associate Professor of Economics, G.T.N Arts & Science College, Dindugal was the resource person. He shared his ideas on what is G-

20? India's role in G-20, List of the member countries, its formation, objectives and working pattern. He elaborated the functions of G-20 with statistics. He also pointed out that India's theme in G-20 is "One-ness" i.e., one-earth, one family & one future. It is also mentioned by the resource person that India's G-20 agenda will be inclusive, ambitious, action-oriented and decisive. He also pointed out the relationship between Liberalisation, Privatisation, Globalisation and G7, G15 and G20. Since it is an intergovernmental forum, it will address the major issues of these 20 member countries on the areas like Population, Energy, Climate change, Mitigation & International financial stability. He also talked about that the working pattern of India's Presidency. India will work to get a glimpse of India's rich cultural heritage and a year-long India experience. The priorities of India's Presidency are accelerated inclusive and Resilient, Growth accelerating progress on SDGs, technological transformation & Digital public infrastructure, multilateral institutions for the 21<sup>st</sup> century and Women – led development. Finally, he insisted about that the students of Commerce should know about LPG its role in structural change of Indian Economy, how India is going to lead the G 20 under its Presidency. ## Constitution Day

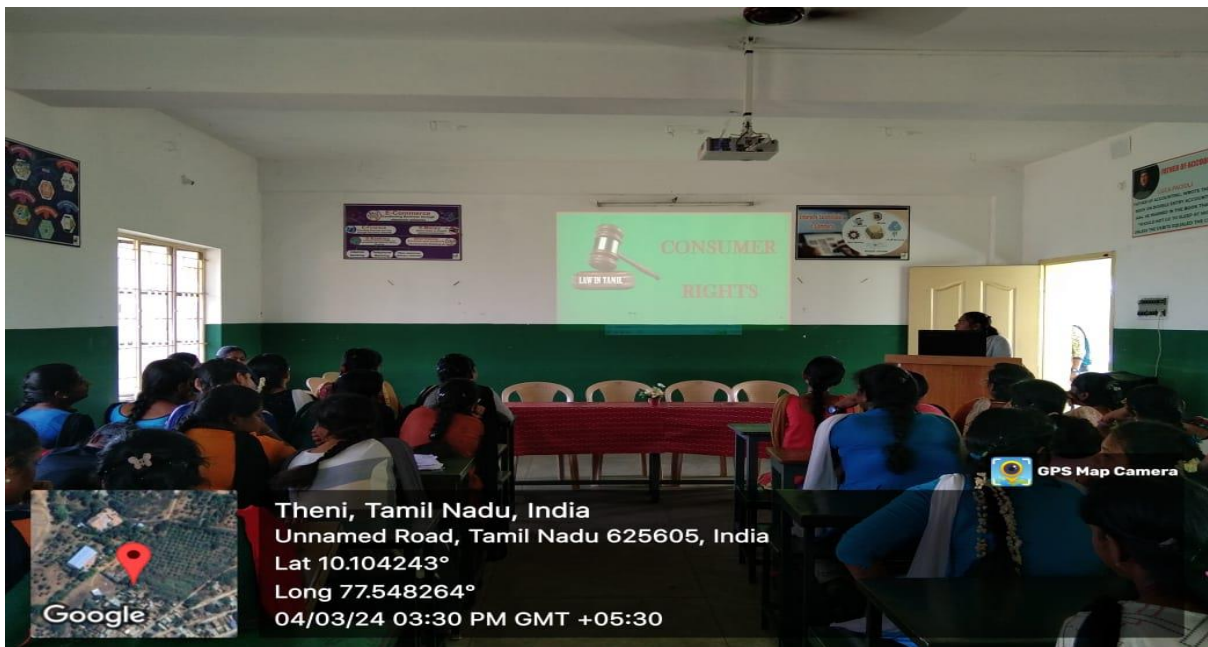
