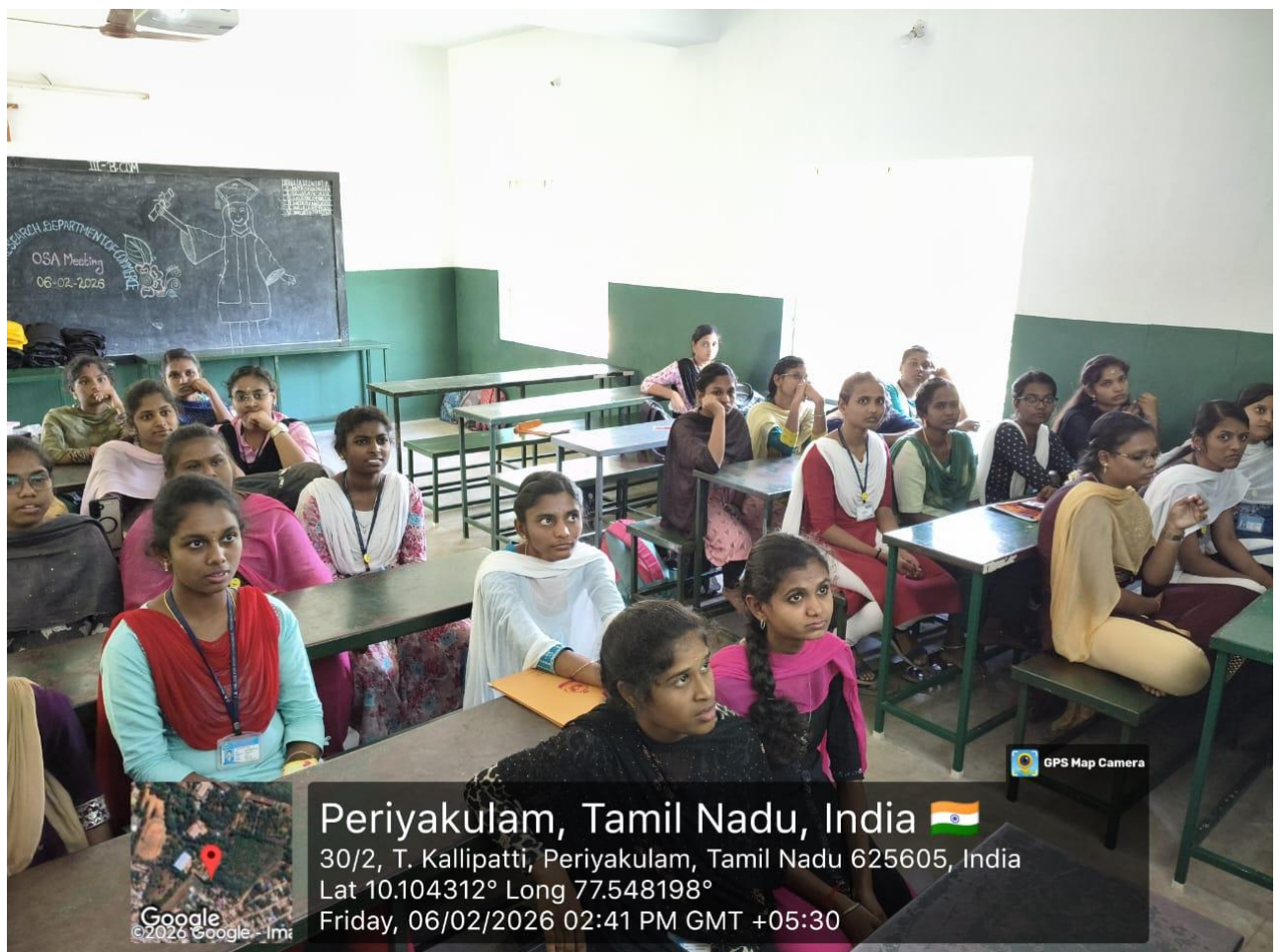
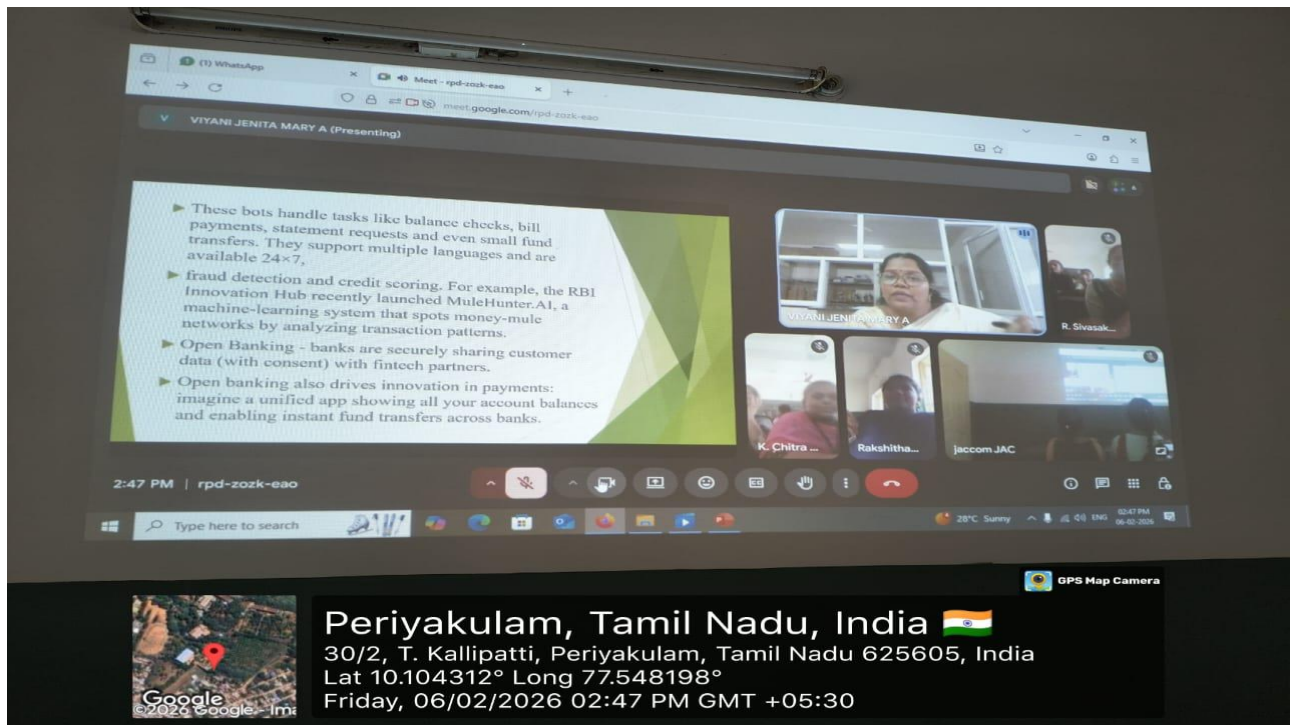


Special Talk

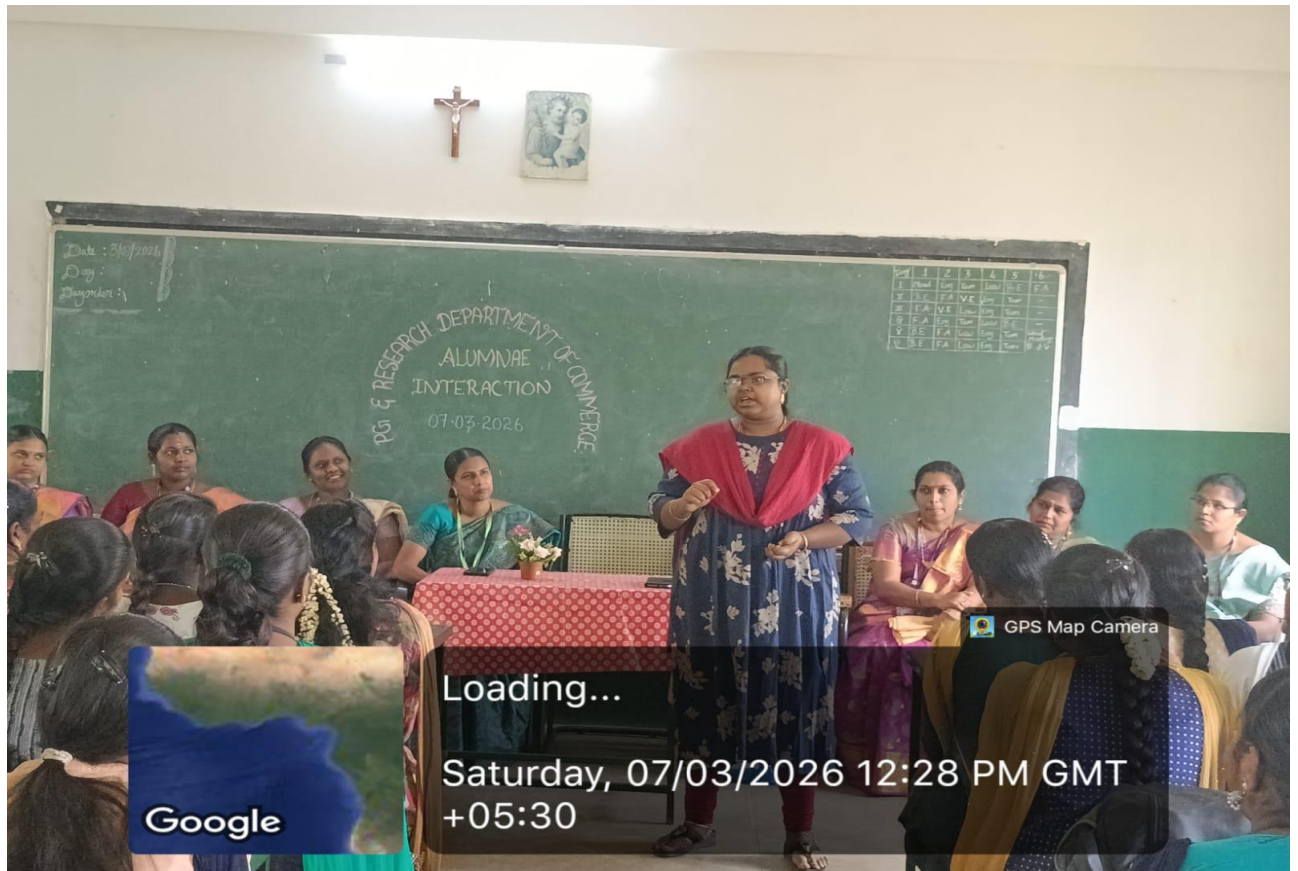
The meeting was started with warm welcome by S. Divya Dharshini-II B. Com who greeted the gathering and highlighted the importance of alumni interaction
