delivered by Ms. R. Rakshana (III BCA), bringing the memorable Freshers' Day Celebration to a joyous close.





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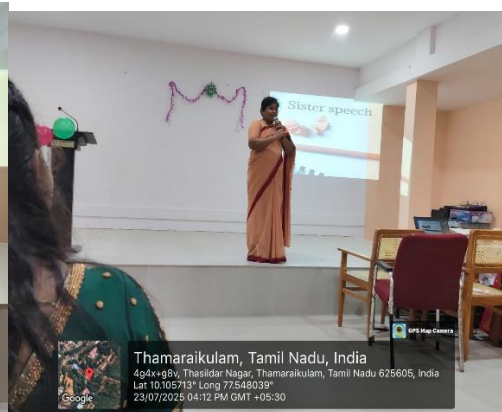
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TECH AWARENESS

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INTERDEPARTMENTAL GUEST LECTURE

REPORT On 05.08.2025

In collaboration with **Vinsup Infotech (P) Ltd.** and the **Institution's Innovation Council (IIC)** of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women (Autonomous), Periyakulam, the Departments of Computer Applications and Computer Science jointly organized a **Interdepartmental Guest Lecture** on 5th August 2025 (Tuesday) at 2:00 p.m. in Ave Maria Hall. The session aimed to enrich students' understanding of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and its real-time applications in the modern world.

The event commenced with a prayer song, followed by Bible reading and prayer. The programme was anchored by **Ms. N. Yazhini** and **Ms. B. Yamuna** of III BCA. A warm welcome was extended by **Ms. R. Kaviyadharshini** and **Ms. O. Afrin Banu**, also from III BCA, who introduced the guest and shared the objective of the session.

Arul Anitha, Head & Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Applications, honoured the Chief Guest, **Mr. Venkatesh Alagarsamy**, Technical and Operations Head, Vinsup Infotech (P) Ltd., Madurai, with a shawl. **Mrs. A. The guest lecture was delivered by **Mr. Venkatesh Alagarsamy, M.C.A.**, who served as the resource person. He addressed the students on the topic: **"AI Unveiled: Understanding the Future of Technology."**

During his session, **Mr. Venkatesh** explained the concept of Artificial Super Intelligence (ASI) and demonstrated the capabilities of an AI assistant tool named Lindy. He showcased how Lindy functions as a virtual professional assistant—automatically replying to emails, drafting messages from simple headings, and sending them appropriately, such as guest lecture invitations through Gmail. This live demo illustrated how AI can reduce manual effort and be effectively utilized in domains like education, business, and the stock market.

He also introduced another AI assistant named NSN and emphasized how

Machine Learning (ML) and Deep Learning (DL) collectively form the core foundation of Artificial Intelligence.

The session was followed by a feedback segment, where students shared their reflections. From III BCA, **Ms. N. Vinothini** and **Ms. G. Nandhini** expressed their thoughts, while from III B.Sc. Computer Science, **Ms. R. Swathi** and **Ms. R. Dhanujashree** appreciated the interactive explanation and real-time demonstrations, which made the concept of AI more relatable and easier to grasp.

The vote of thanks was delivered by **Ms. R. Dhanujashree** of III B.Sc. Computer Science, who expressed sincere gratitude to the speaker, department heads, faculty members, and fellow students for their enthusiastic participation and support.

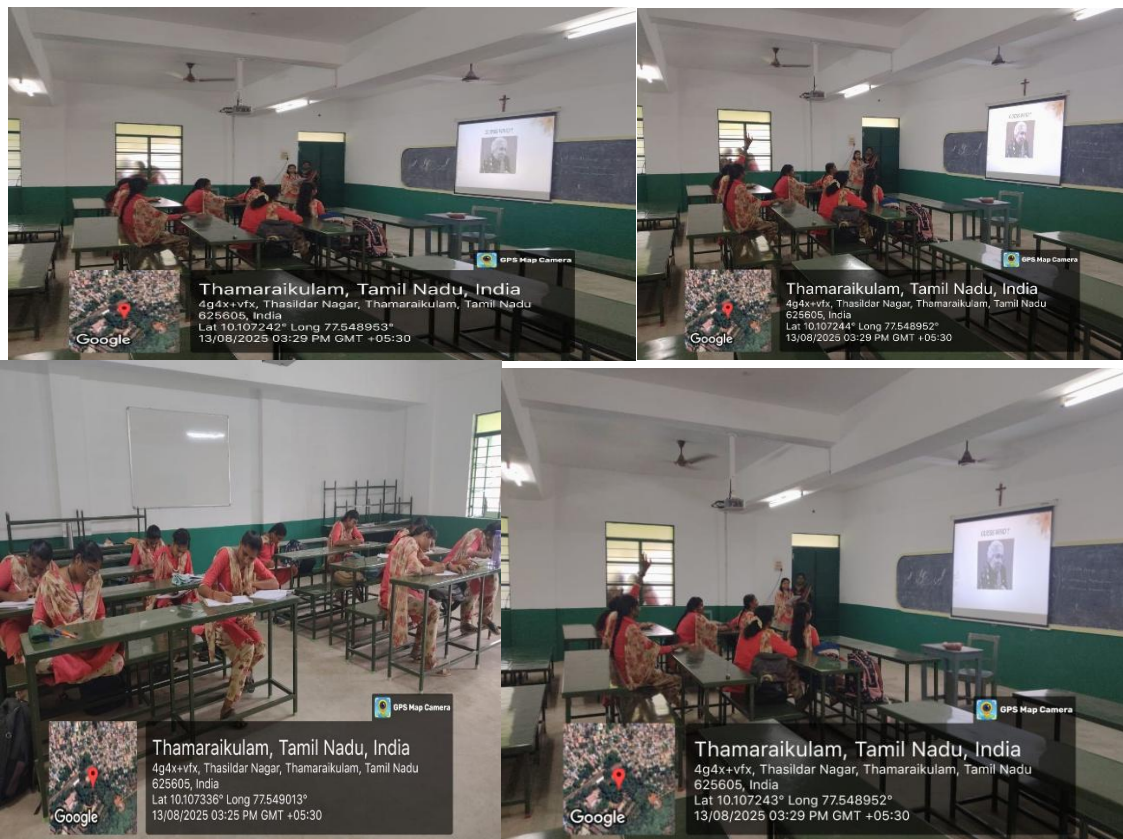

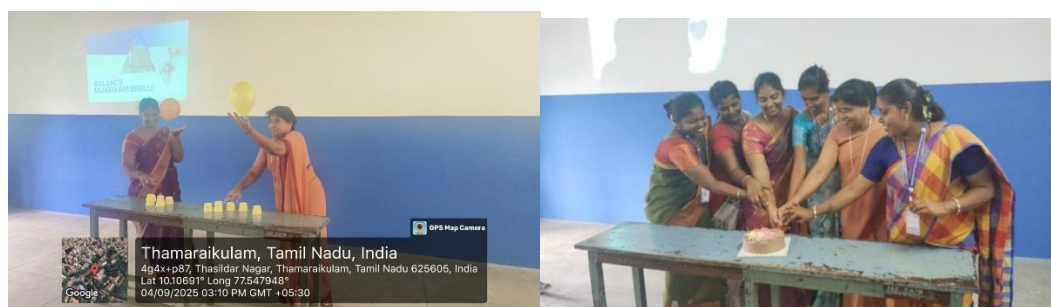

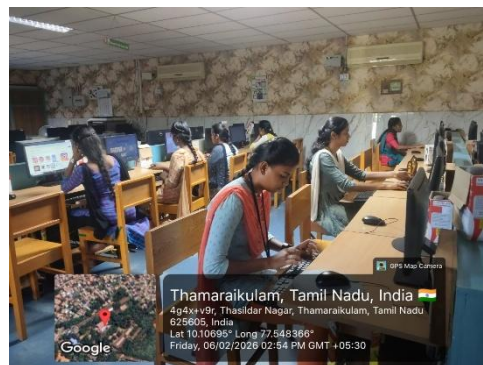
